

Autocross Kings rules and regulations

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I. General rules and regulations

I.1. What is AutocrossKing

- I.1.1. Autocross King (the series) is an Autocross series organized and promoted by WebAvenue in accordance with the National sporting code of the Bahrain Motor Federation (BMF).
- I.1.2. The series will be carried out over 3 rounds in Ramadan of 2016 at the Bahrain international circuit (BIC)
- I.1.3. The organizers reserve the right to update, amend and supplement the rules through Bulletins sent directly to the competitors via email.
- I.1.4. The organizers reserve the right to Amend the schedule by adding or canceling rounds when necessary due to Force majeure and are not liable for damages incurred.

I.2. The Series

- I.2.1. the series consists of 3 rounds held in Ramadan 2016.
- I.2.2. Rounds: (to be confirmed)

Round 1: June 9th 2016

Round 2: June 23 2016

Round 3: June 30 2016

(Round dates are subject to confirmation by the venue and the approval of the rules by the BMF)

I.3. Who can participate

- I.3.1. All participants must 15 years of age or older; holders of a valid Class D license or the equivalent from their respective ASN. participants younger than 18 years must have approval from their parent/guardian.
- I.3.2. All participants must show ownership papers of the vehicle or consent from the vehicle owner.

I.4.1. Entry fees.

Preregistration online is BD 25/round.

Registration on the day is BD 35/round.

Second car registration is BD 10 online or on the day.

1.5. Points and awards

- 1.5.1. Awards, trophies and/or medals will be provided by the organizers and sponsors.
- 1.5.2. Trophies and/or medals will be presented to the fastest three of each class.
- 1.5.3. Special awards: awards by sponsors for promotional use only, no championship points will count for special awards.

Special award examples:

- Make cup. Award presented to fastest lap by XYZ make (ex. fastest Audi cup)
- Tire cup. Award presented to fastest lap to drivers using XYZ tire (ex. fastest lap on Michelin PSS)
- Fuel cup. Award presented to fastest lap to drivers using XYZ fuel (ex. fastest lap on MSI03)

Other promotional awards can be introduced throughout the season.

Championship points per round will be as follows.

2. Events and Procedures

2.1. Entries

- 2.1.1. The rules and regulations of Autocross King will be available for download on the official page after approval by the ASN. All registered competitors will receive the rule book on email after registration.
- 2.1.2. All competitors are required to register by filling the online form with correct and complete information to be listed as championship contenders.
- 2.1.3. Entry fees must be paid in full in cash prior to each event. No refunds will be made in case of withdrawal, cancellations or rounds by the organizers are subject to refund.

2.2. Briefing

- 2.2.1. Competitors are required to attend all briefing sessions, briefing times and locations will be posted prior to every round. Missing briefing sessions will be penalized as per the BMF sporting code.

2.3. Scrutineering

- 2.3.1. The organizer will designate scrutineers approved by the BMF.
- 2.3.2. All vehicles must be available for scrutiny in the time posted prior to each round.
- 2.3.3. All vehicles must comply with the technical rules and regulation of its class.
- 2.3.4. It is the competitors responsibility to make sure the vehicle complies with the rules and regulations.
- 2.3.5. All vehicles are subject to scrutiny after timed sessions.

2.4. Event Format

- 2.4.1. Practice: Each competitor is allowed 2 practice runs + 1 track walk
- 2.4.2. Hot laps: each competitor can make up to 2 hot laps.
- 2.4.3. Super Round: the top 2 finishers of each class will take part in super round where they will be competing in the same vehicle and will be allowed One practice lap and One timed lap.

2.5. Timing

- 2.5.1. Timing will be recorded using a timing system.
- 2.5.2. Timing will be published immediately after every session.
- 2.5.3. Timing will available and displayed at the end of each run.
- 2.5.4. Time will be counted in minutes to an accuracy of thousands of seconds (mm:ss.000)
- 2.5.5. Best times will be posted on www.trackfight.com/Autocross

2.6. General track regulations

- 2.6.1. Drivers are responsible for the conduct and behavior of their crew members and guests, misconduct by any crew member or guest will be penalized.
- 2.6.2. Speed limits in the paddock and general public areas must be strictly followed.
- 2.6.3. Leave only your footprints, please do not leave parts or waste anywhere in the track. Session marshals must be immediately notified of any water, lubricant, or fuel spillage.

3. Technical regulations

- 3.1. The track layout will be format marked with rubber cones or white lines, whichever is available.
- 3.2. Vehicles and classes

All vehicles must be free of any mechanical problems and leaks. Vehicles in all classes must maintain factory orientation and factory frame, modifications to the suspension, drivetrain, and breaks are otherwise permitted. Gasoline, diesel, hybrid and full electric powered vehicles are allowed.

Classes

Modifications are recommended for all classes

street (Street tires only)

- S1 - naturally aspirated vehicles up to 2300cc
- S2 - Naturally aspirated vehicles up to 3700cc
- S3 - Naturally aspirated vehicles up to 4000cc
- S4 - Naturally aspirated vehicles up to 5700cc
- ST - Forced induction 4 cylinder only maximum 2500cc

Super Street (street tires only)

This class includes:

- naturally aspirated 5800cc and above.
- turbo charged 2600cc and above.
- turbo charged rotary

Examples: Corvette Z06, Skyline GTR, 911 GT2.

Super Car class

- Super car - Ferrari 458, Lamborghini Aventador, McLaren 650S, Porsche turbo S.
- Hyper car - McLaren P1, McLaren F1, LaFerrari, CLK GTR.. etc

- 3.3. Branding and sponsors

all vehicles must carry the series branding in the locations advised by the series staff on the day.

3.4. Vehicle safety

Roll bars and cages are not mandatory but are highly advised.

Fire extinguishers are not mandatory but are highly advised.

3.5. Driver Safety

drivers in all classes must wear a helmet meeting SNELL or SFI Specifications or BSI BS 6658-85 type A (including all amendments) Specs.

SFI Spec 31.1 = SNELL SA, open-face helmet.

SFI Spec 31.2 = SNELL SA, full-face helmet.

Drivers of any open bodied car wearing an "open face" helmet, must wear protective goggles. Modifications to helmet/visor/shield are prohibited. All helmets must have the appropriate certification sticker affixed inside the helmet.

Gloves are not mandatory but are highly advised.

Flame resistant clothing is not mandatory but is highly advised.

4. Penalties and Disputes

4.1. Penalties

A 2 second penalty will be added to the competitor's time for every track boundary infringement (dropping cones, exiting boundaries..etc)

4.2. Sporting disputes

4.2.1. Sporting Disputes about the regulations and the application of said regulations will be settled by the stewards of the meeting under the bylaws of the Bahrain motor federation (BMF). Stewards decisions are subject to appeal at the federation level.

4.3. Technical disputes

4.3.1. Technical disputes will be settled in consultation with series scrutineers.

4.4. Queries, protests and appeals.

4.4.1. All queries regarding technical or sporting matters must be made to the permanent race director in writing.

4.4.2. Protests and appeals must be made in writing and in accordance to the BMF sporting code.
